- An exhibitor may only have 2 entries in a class and may not exceed a total of 8 rabbits. Any rabbit not entered in the correct class will be disqualified.
- 5. Purebred rabbits must be true to breed. Papers are not required.
- 6. All rabbits must have a tattoo or waterproof marker number.
- 7. Rabbits under 3 months of age, pregnant or lactating does will be sent home.
- Exhibitors must care for their rabbits. Exhibitors must also supply their own food and water dishes. Crocks are required.
- Rabbits will be inspected upon arrival for general health soundness, ear mites, cold, injuries or any ailments that might affect the other rabbits. Any rabbit not passing the health exam must be removed from the grounds immediately by the owner or the Fair will remove them.
