1. Competition is open to residents of all counties.
2. Entry blanks are in the back of the Fair book. Additional blanks may be copied or picked up at the Fair office.
3. **Entries close Wednesday, July 19 at 4 p.m.** Late entries may be accepted with Superintendent approval. Late fee will be entry fee plus \$5.00 each.
4. Entry fee:

Dairy, single & group class	\$3.00

Rabbit	\$.40
5. Owners of all breeding beef, dairy, goats & sheep will be required to show papers. List owners on entry form.
6. Exhibitors who are not Agricultural Society members will purchase an exhibitor's pass for \$15.00. If more than 4 hooved animals entered by one exhibitor, a second pass may be purchased.
7. All animal exhibitors needing to delivery feed/hay must have a vehicle pass and will enter through the 10th Street gate. Passes will be assigned by department Superintendent or front office. Passes will be limited to keep excess vehicles off the grounds.
8. During the day, exhibitors may rest in the barns, out of the aisles. No beds may be used. Due to health regulations concerning E-Coli and other contaminations, cooking and eating in the livestock areas is not recommended.

DEPARTMENT C - ALPACAS

1. Please refer to general rules on page 9.
2. Showmanship will be judged Wednesday, July 31 at 9 a.m. Alpacas will be judged on Friday, August 2 at 9:00 a.m.
3. Alpacas must be in place by 4pm on the Sunday prior to the opening of the fair and will be released at 6pm on the following Sunday.
4. Showmanship is limited to one entry per exhibitor. Shorn halter is limited to one entry per class. There is no limit to entries in Obstacle class.
5. All exhibitors will show in black pants, white shirt and sturdy footwear.
6. Animals will be housed with 4-H alpacas.

Open Showmanship – one alpaca per exhibitor

Shorn Halter Class- judged on fleece and conformation -Juvenile (6 months under 1 years on show day)

Obstacle Class - Novice – open to any age or gender alpaca that has not placed first through third more than three times

Advanced – open to alpacas that are no longer eligible for Novice. Once shown in Advanced or Master the alpaca may not be shown in Novice

Master – the most challenging course open to any alpacas, but once shown in Master alpaca may not be shown in Novice or Advanced

DEPARTMENT D - CATTLE

- Holsteins will be judged on Tuesday at 8:30 a.m.. All other dairy breeds will be judges on Saturday at 8:30 a.m.
- Holsteins must be in place on Sunday, prior to Fair, by 12:00 p.m. and will be released Wednesday at 3:00 p.m. Other breeds must be in place by Thursday at 12:00 p.m. and will be released Sunday at 6:00 p.m.
- There is no limit to entries in any one class. However, an exhibitor is limited to 2 cash prizes in individual classes and 1 cash prize in group classes.
- 4-H animals will be housed in the 4-H barn. Open class animals will be housed in the open barn.
- Identified, qualified and registered Holsteins may be entered in calf & heifer classes. Qualified and registered Holsteins may be entered in cow classes.
- No animal can be advanced ahead. They must be shown at exact age.

Age of animals:

Spring Calf	Born after March 1 of current year
Winter Calf	Born between Dec. 1 last year and Feb. 29 of current year
Fall Calf	Born between Sept. 1 & Nov. 30 of last year
Summer Yearling	Born between June 1 & Aug. 31 of last year
Spring Yearling	Born between March 1 & May 31 of last yr
Winter Yrlng	Born between Dec. 1, two years ago, & Feb. 29 last year
Fall Yearling	Born between Sept. 1 & Nov. 30, two yrs ago
Junior 2 Year Old	Born between March 1 & Aug. 31, two years ago
