The judge may reclassify fleeces at his discretion.

2. Poultry will be judged on Sunday, preceding Fair, at 5:00 p.m.
3. Poultry must be in place on Sunday, preceding Fair, by 11:00 a.m. and will be released on Sunday, last day of Fair, at 6:00 p.m.
4. All chickens must be certified Typhoid Pollurum Free. Provide certificates upon entry.
5. All poultry must be identified in the American Standard of Perfection, except for production-type crossbreeds and show class purebreds not found in the Standard. These can only show in the show class.
6. Birds showing signs of lice, mites or contagious disease will be disqualified and must be removed from the grounds by the owner with 24 hours or they will be removed by the Fair.
7. An exhibitor may enter no more than 10 birds total.
8. An exhibit shall be a single bird, except in group classes.
9. Birds hatched prior to January 1 of current year will be considered old. Those hatched after that date will be considered young. No birds hatched after May 1 of current year may be entered.
10. Breed and variety should be identified on the entry form.
11. Exhibitors must care for their birds. They must also supply their own food and water dishes.

2. Rabbits will be judged on Tuesday at 5:00 p.m., following 4-H rabbits.
3. Rabbits must be in place on Sunday, preceding Fair, by 11:00 a.m. and will be released on Sunday, last day of Fair, at 6:00 p.m.
4. An exhibitor may only have 2 entries in a class and may not exceed a total of 8 rabbits. Any rabbit not entered in the correct class will be disqualified.
5. Purebred rabbits must be true to breed. Papers are not required.
6. All rabbits must have a tattoo or waterproof marker number.
7. Rabbits under 3 months of age, pregnant or lactating does will be sent home.
8. Exhibitors must care for their rabbits. Exhibitors must also supply their own food and water dishes. Crocks are required.
9. Rabbits will be inspected upon arrival for general health soundness, ear mites, cold, injuries or any ailments that might affect the other rabbits. Any rabbit not passing the health exam must be removed from the grounds immediately by the owner or the Fair will remove them.
