Enclosed please find a temporary RV parking application for this summer's Fair.

Please read these reminders carefully before completing the application.

- Fair will start on Saturday, July 27 and end on Saturday, August 3.
- Animals will be released on Sunday, August 4 (not on Saturday).
- Camp vehicles may not be moved off the grounds until Sunday morning, August 4.
- NO vehicles will be parked at the campsites inside the gates. This includes cars, trucks, motorcycles, etc. Personal vehicles will be parked in the lot on 10th St or behind the grandstand. You will be provided ample storage space for feed and supplies. Bring what you need at the beginning of your stay.
- Camping begins Thursday before start of fair. However, there are some who feel the need to move their campers into the assigned spots several days ahead. If you are one of those people, you will be charged extra whether the camper is hooked up or not.
 - If you bring your camper Tuesday, add \$50 to the weekly price.
 - If you bring your camper Wednesday, add \$25 to the weekly price.
 - Any dropped off before Tuesday will not be allowed to park.
 - Any dropped off before Tuesday when there is no staff on the grounds will be removed when staff returns.
- Per state veterinarian, bringing pets camping is discouraged. If you are bringing a dog, make sure rabies documentation is available. Dogs must stay in your campsite area, leashed or crated. They are not allowed in or near the barns, entrance/exit gates or on the midway.
- If you are interested in reserving a site, please complete and return the enclosed form, along with your payment. No sites will be held if incomplete.
- Last year you were assigned # _____. This is for your information only. There is no guarantee you will be assigned the same spot this year.

- Temporary RV parking is provided as a convenience for our exhibitors who need to care for animals. We are <u>not</u> a campground.
- Campfires are not allowed.
- The area provided to you is limited. This is especially true at the end of the week when 10th St. sites are doubled up. Many spots are very close to roads and/or show rings. No extra tents, tarps, tables, structures, toys, vehicles, etc. are allowed. Fair officials will have the final decision to determine whether or not something is considered extraneous.
- Trailer pumping is provided by the portable toilet company that services the Fair.
 We do not determine the price charged. Provide cash payment to the front office the night before you want it pumped. This year's rate is yet to be determined.
- Enclosed is a document regarding electrical boxes and gray water disposal. Please return with your application. Your application will not accepted without signature.
- Direct any concerns, questions, suggestions, etc. during Fair week to the front office.
- Site assignments will not be confirmed until after July 1. Please feel free to call after this date.
- Campsite requests received by July 1 will be filled as requested, if available. After July 1, preference to returning campers is not guaranteed.

Everyone wants to enjoy a good Fair week experience.

Harassment of or fighting with fellow campers/department superintendents and/or ignoring rules as stated in this letter will not be tolerated.

Repeat violations will result in removal from the grounds, without refund.

Not disposing of gray-water in appropriate areas.

I understand a dump station is provided in the back parking lot for vendor camping use. Tri-R Services will also be on the grounds to pump tanks. I will contact the front office for this service. Furthermore, I understand that if I violate this rule, the first offense will be a \$250 fine and the second offense will be an additional \$250 fine and removal from the fairgrounds, forfeiting my space as well as fees paid.
