

**ATTENTION INSTRUCTOR
RULES FOR ACADEMY - ALL SEATS**

ACADEMY CLASSES - are open to riders who actively participate in a lesson program (with an instructor that teaches more than one student and accepts remuneration for such) provided they have not shown in any division at any show with the exception of 4H.

HORSES - The same horse can be used twice in the same class - the class can only be split once for the use of the same horse, per class. Horses must be a mare or gelding earning their living as a lesson horse. Open horses not regular used as a school horse for regular lessons may not be used as an academy horse. School horses may be owned or leased by a rider as long as the horse earns it's living as a lesson horse. Horses may be any breed.
Neat presentation is encouraged, clean, clipping of bridle path, legs & etc.

RIDERS - Riders age will be determined by USEF Rules (Dec 1st of the previous year). Riders who have previously shown other than Academy and/or 4H regardless of seat shown are not eligible for Academy classes. Exception - Adult Riders who have had at least a ten year break from showing. Riders who have cantered at any show or tournament are not eligible to compete in Walk Trot Only classes.

ATTIRE - All Riders - Protective helmets are the ONLY permitted headgear. Permitted attire for academy classes are long sleeved button down shirts. Pants and paddock boots or seat specific pants & boots. Vests, ties, gloves and whips are optional. Riding Habits are prohibited. Hair should be neatly pulled back in a bun or braid and should NOT obstruct the riders number.

TACK - The horse should be tacked as if giving a lesson. Snaffle or show bridles are acceptable. Martingales are encouraged for young riders. Any leverage bit or rein placed through a martingale is prohibited.

JUDGING - The horse is NOT to be judged. Exhibitors are to be judge on their skill to effectively control the horse to it's best advantage. In Equitation classes the rider only is to be judged. Walk, Trot, Canter classes & Walk Trot only are to be judged both directions of the ring at the appropriate gaits. No additional tests are allowed. Pleasure or Equitation should be judged with emphasis on the riders showmanship, ring awareness and horsemanship abilities.
